The DPS Crime module will be updated with the Advocates Graduate Fee Scheme (AGFS) which produces advocates legal aid bills quickly and easily. The system comes complete with a .NET Criminal Billing Module which produces up-to-the-minute billing reports for the month, and an easy-to-use crime diary.

For solicitors practicing Family law, DPS Software have updated their family module with the LSC billing system. This modification is designed to speed up and streamline the billing process, cutting time and costs for practices.

Practices using DPS case and accounts have reduced their fee earner secretarial ratios to 5-1, and less. DPS' case management system can optionally operate entirely within MS Outlook™, and has been nominated for The Legal Technology Awards "**Best Integrated Software 2009**".
