Due to the success of the Cashier installation they are currently in the process of upgrading to the One Office system. This is due to be in place in the next 3 months. The upgrade means that they will now have one database serving both their accounts and case management systems without the need to enter matter details in twice. They will also be able to benefit from having the capacity to import CDS6 and automate CDS6 receipting. This will all run on a SQL database, thus providing better database management allowing scalability and reliability.

Kaim Todner have also taken extensive measures in regards to disaster recovery. DPS have helped with the installation of a central comprehensive data recovery system which includes anti-virus software, email scanning and online data back up.
